Colombia Mission Team Returns

The mission team to Cartagena, Colombia is back after a wonderful trip. Three people went on this fact finding trip to see what God is doing in Colombia and how FBCSA fits into that picture. We saw first-hand our own Southern Baptist Missionaries speaking Spanish while working side by side with people from the barrios. On Thursday we visited a barrio where the homes are made of cinder block or adobe with tin roofs and dirt floors. The people are very gracious and invited us into their homes to hear bible stories. Friday we looked at lodging accommodations and toured the city center. Saturday we went swimming with youth from a different barrio. They were eager to have conversation and learn more about us. Hearing them sing during their Bible time was uplifting. These people are excited to learn about God and His greatness. Several opportunities for future visits were visible including medical/dental assistance, VBS for the children, seminars on marriage and family, storying (telling stories in a specific sequence time after time), and sports camps to name a few.

Colombia Prayer Requests

- Team meetings – that they are focused on what God is calling them to do and be sensitive to His leading.
- Family time and homeschooling
- Arjona – mission work within 3 barrios; that Christ's light would shine and decisions would be made to follow Jesus Christ.
- Sports time – work within 2 barrios playing sports and telling Bible stories.
- Presenting Biblical marriage and family teachings.
