In cooperation with the 2011 Strategic Plan, First Baptist Church will take two important steps in the next few weeks.

Under the leadership of Josh Vaughan, our Minister to Young Marrieds, twenty FBC families will be enlisted to pilot a new kind of worship service from September – January.
