Founders Day 2013 Cadwallader Award Recipient

Did you know that First Baptist Church has won a city championship? Several, in fact...in boys' basketball and softball, back in the 1940s, '70s and '80s.

One of the men responsible for those championships was Jim Eckelkamp, our 2013 Cadwallader Award Recipient.

Jim was born in Electra, Texas. He served as a mechanic in the Air Force and was stationed in the Pacific. It was there that he excelled as a softball fast pitcher. His love of softball, both fast and slow pitch, continues to this day.

His sisters introduced him to his beloved wife, Irene, whom he married here in the chapel of First Baptist Church in 1946. In 1953 they returned to San Antonio and remained. They had three children and four grandchildren.

Jim worked and retired from Kelly Air Force Base as an aircraft mechanic. As Randy Garner said of Mr. Eckelkamp, "He could work with his hands, take things apart, and then put them back together again like nobody else I know." He still has a 1956 Nash in his garage, says his son Jimmy.

Jim worked in RAs (Royal Ambassadors) for 30 plus years--from the 1960s to the 1990s. He taught young boys outdoor skills and took them on fabulous campouts. They built fiberglass canoes, rebuilt lawnmowers and other engines. The RA pledge or motto is still remembered by most of those former RAs...because Mr. Eckelkamp repeated it so often.

Jim's love of softball continued as he coached young boys elementary age through middle school. In 1972, the First Baptist team won the San Antonio Sunday School League City Championship. Jim assisted in coaching basketball and was involved in Community Missions as well. He worked on Alamo Street for a number of years, handing out clothes. He counted money upstairs every Monday morning. He served on various committees, and he is a lifetime deacon.

Jim is a godly man, a true servant of the Lord. The Floy Cadwallader Award is given each year to men and women who have devoted their lives to serving Christ at First Baptist Church, and this year's deserving recipient is Jim Eckelkamp.
