**DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME** - Don't forget to "Spring" forward next Sunday, March 10.

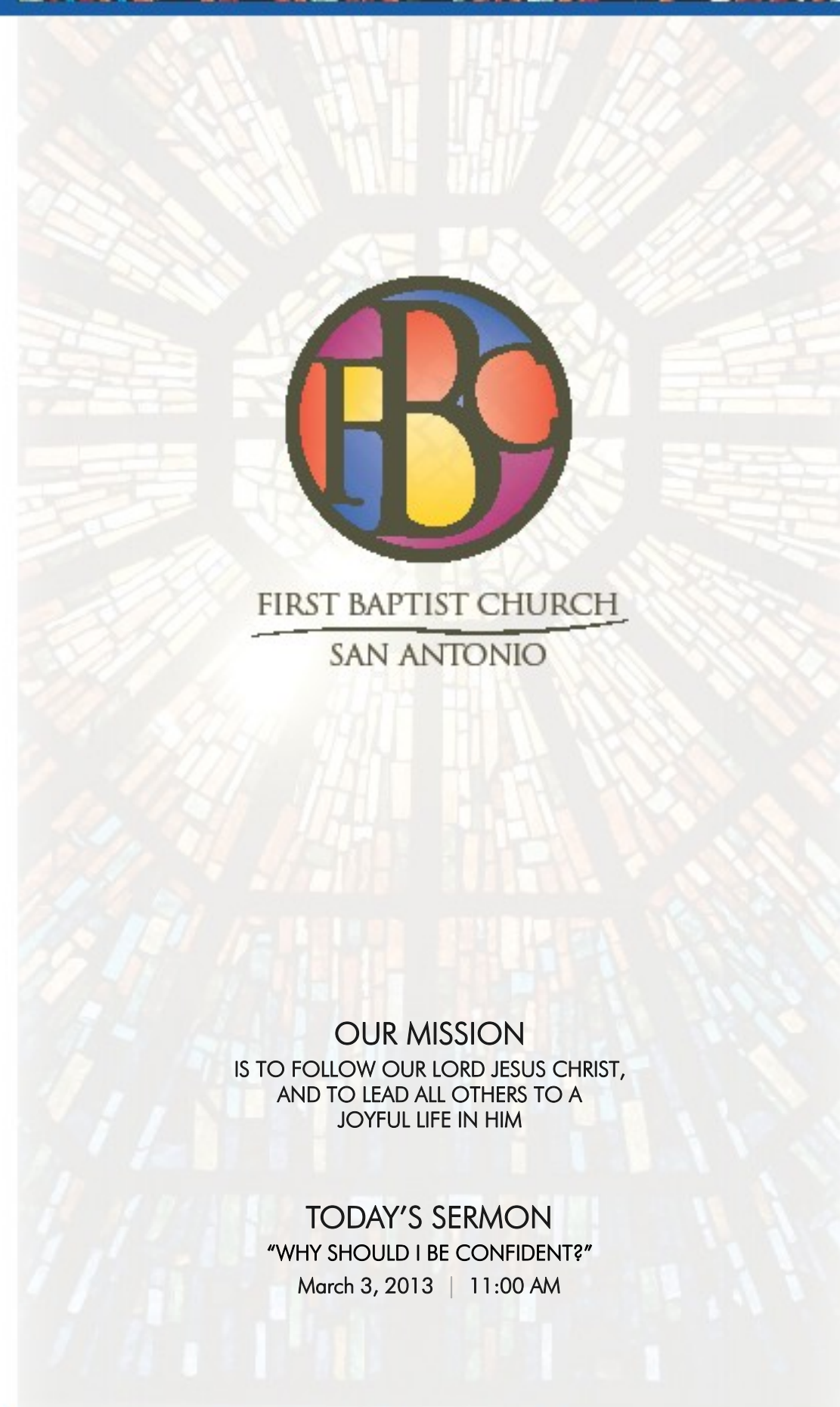
