### Keep FBC Cool!

Much progress has been made toward the funding necessary for the new air conditioning system for the Sanctuary and West Hall. We have raised \$900,000 towards our goal of \$1.8 million. In order to keep our goal of a January install, the church will need to sign documents by the end of this month agreeing to make staggered payments throughout the rest of the year. To not fix this now is to risk a system failure that would be disastrous. A failure of this kind would keep us out of the Sanctuary for months trying to fix the problem without adequate prep and scheduling time.

For the next several weeks we will be discussing this project with you. Please pray, please give. Together we can accomplish this goal.
