What are Area Fellowships? Cross-generational gatherings of people live near each other and who meet together to share fun, food and friendship with other FBCSA attenders in their area.

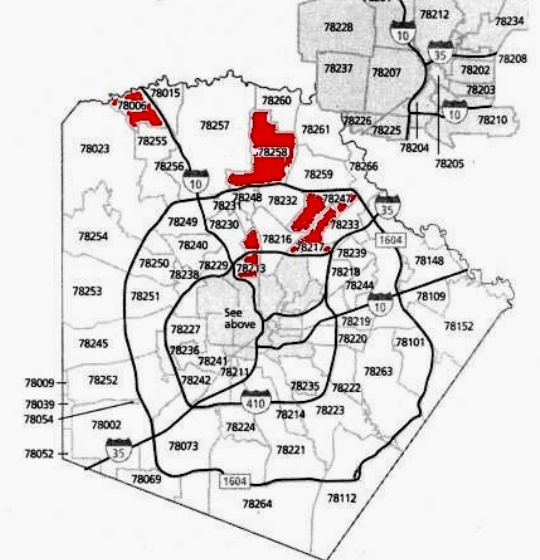
When do Area Fellowships meet? Most will meet once a month for 3 months on Sunday evenings beginning in September. Sign up and a host team will contact you with more details.
