Thousands of children in San Antonio do not have that opportunity because school supplies are not affordable for families struggling for the basic necessities. Out of an awareness of that need, First Baptist Church began its Backpack Ministry six years ago. Each year we have grown in our ability to provide more and more backpacks filled with supplies. Last year we gave over 300 backpacks to our International Ministry children as well as students at Lamar Elementary and Briscoe Academy in the San Antonio ISD, and to scholarship students at Sunshine Cottage for hearing impaired children.
