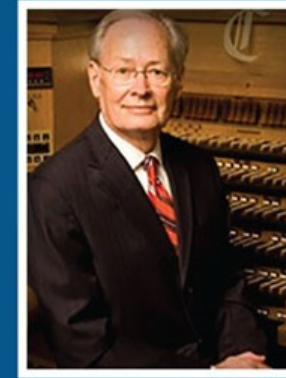

Dr. Albert L. Travis is Distinguished Professor Emeritus of Organ at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. He served on the faculty of the School of Church Music from 1977 to 2008. Dr. Travis has been Organist of Broadway Baptist Church in Fort Worth since 1978, and is currently serving as Organist and Director of Music Ministries. Dr. Travis can be heard on a compact disc recording playing the Jongen Symphonie Concertante and the Saint-Saëns Organ Symphony with the Fort Worth Symphony. He also appears on three other CD's of hymn festivals recorded at Broadway Baptist Church. Dr. Travis maintains an active schedule as hymn festival leader, improvisation workshop clinician, arranger, and composer.
