In His mighty arms He bears them.

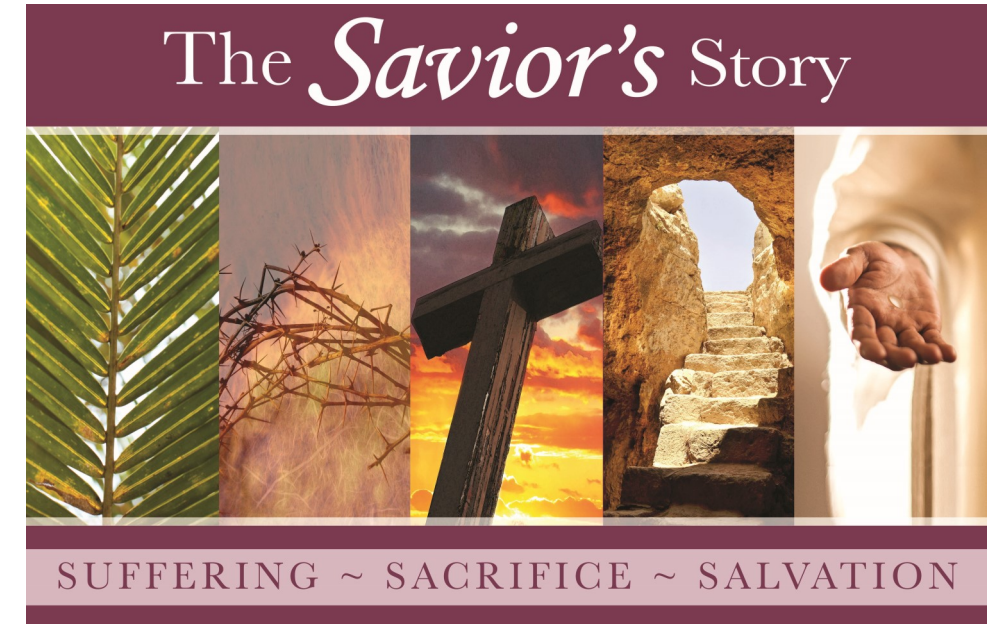
