Join us for our first installment of the FFA Spring Concert Series featuring organist Matthias Maierhofer today at 3:00 PM in the Sanctuary.

Matthias Maierhofer was born in 1979 in Graz, Austria. He is the recipient of a celebrated organ-playing tradition which leads in a direct line back to Maurice Duruflé and Karl Straube. As an award-winning performer he specializes in improvisation and playing a wide range of historic instruments and music, ranging from medieval music through the 21st-Century.

From 2005 to 2009, Matthias Maierhofer was director of music and organist at St. Albertus Magnus Church in Freiburg, Germany. He has also taught at the Hochschule für Musik in Freiburg. Beginning in 2009, Matthias Maierhofer was a faculty member of the Hochschule für Musik und Theater "Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy" in Leipzig, Germany, where he taught organ and improvisation. In 2013 he was appointed Professor of Organ and Sacred Music at The University of Texas at Austin.
